Thanks to the support of the Heritage Lottery Fund (HLF) the church has been lovingly and skilfully restored.

The Evelyn Gibbs murals, the beautiful barrel vault ceiling and the east window, all hidden as a result of the 1970s extension, have been revealed.

The level access and the new underfloor heating means the church is warm and welcoming for all visitors.



The best way to prevent the building falling into disrepair and decay again is to ensure that it is regularly maintained and used as much as possible. As a result of the HLF supported Hidden Treasures Project the church is now open to visitors three days a week in addition to Sunday, offers special events and hosts regular community activities.
